Differentiating With A Continuum: Planning Across Grade Bands To Reach Every Student



This resource offers a starting point for teachers to organize and plan instruction using any standards or curriculum.



According to Component 1d of the CPS Framework for Teaching, a distinguished teacher's lessons are:
-fully aligned to standards-based learning objectives

-designed to engage students in high-level cognitive activities suitable for every student

-paced appropriately and... differentiated, as appropriate, for individual learners. Teachers of young children knows the importance of the foundation we lay and how it affects students' future school performance. Our efforts to improve outcomes for students must be aligned as early as possible, so we must consider the range of student ability and prepare to differentiate when planning instruction. As such, we must create continua that span the entire grade range included under the umbrella of "early childhood"; preschool-3rd grade.

Students exist on a continuum of development, so how do teachers ensure lessons we teach reach every student?

By planning activities and assessments that also exist on a continuum!
