News You Can Use

This month, we begin the study of number, what it means, and what we use numerals for. You may find your child counting everything, so play along! Count how many steps it takes to get from the sidewalk to the door. Name the numbers on the aisles at the grocery store. Help them to notice the numbers all around us, and to use them to understand their world.

Now that we have taken a look at all of the letters of the alphabet, we will also discuss proper use of capital and lowercase letters when writing and the difference between letters,

words and sentences. These are big ideas for early readers and writers to understand. When practicing name writing at home, remind your child to capitalize ONLY the first letter and use lowercase for the others.

Last, please remember to encourage the kids to keep their belongings off of the floor near the cubbies, messy floors make for dirty kids! Also, during this time of uncertain weather, please make the necessary adjustments to pick up your child on time. Kids notice when all of their classmates have left them

behind.
